## Dear Secretary Vilsack:

As representatives of states with substantial chicken operations, we respectfully request that the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) grant an extension of the comment period for the above-referenced proposed rule and Advanced Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR). We believe an extension is needed for stakeholders to consider and properly analyze the proposal.

The proposed rule, which would establish additional disclosure requirements for performancebased poultry grower compensation arrangements, and the ANPR, which seeks extensive comments and information to inform policy development and future rulemaking proposals regarding the use of poultry grower ranking systems, would both have wide-ranging effects on current industry operations. Therefore, they should be considered together. Indeed, it is difficult to ascertain the full effects of the proposed rule without simultaneously having the chance to consider USDA's other forthcoming rules. As you know, the chicken industry is essential to our domestic food security and to global food security because of our significant exports. We therefore urge you to let stakeholders comment on all proposed rules together and to take steps to mitigate any interruptions to the poultry supply chain.
