Dear Secretary Vilsack,

As Co-Chairs of the Congressional Chicken Caucus, we respectfully request that the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) grant a 180-day extension of the comment period for its proposed rule and proposed determination – Salmonella Framework for Raw Poultry Products.

Given the complexity and length of the proposed rule and the fact that nearly all chicken marketed in the United States will be impacted, we believe it is essential to provide affected integrators and producers with additional time to offer thorough and meaningful feedback. Furthermore, the rule raises numerous questions due to its lack of clarity, making an extended comment period even more critical.

For the above-referenced reasons, we respectfully request that the comment period for the proposed rule and proposed determination entitled "Salmonella Framework for Raw Poultry Products" be extended by 180 days so that it closes on April 4, 2025.
